This is the place you will call home.






The glorious abundance surrounding The Residence is reflected within the house itself. This is living on a grand scale.





Extravagantly comfortable seating as the lights dim and it's camera, action. Give top billing to your own favourite movie stars, a special retreat, just for you.






Enjoy a cocktail while the latest movie has you reaching for the popcorn. Sit in comfort, your own private lightshow.

And here there is the sense of unfettered space – your space.



The Residence is situated in North London, on the edge of Kenwood, one of the capital's historic wooded parklands.

Standing proudly on Hampstead Heath from the early 17th century, a prime example of architect Robert Adam's style, Kenwood keeps watch over its ample grounds. Humphrey Repton designed the gardens, and modern sculpture by Barbara Hepworth and Henry Moore now sit within the grounds.

Crowning the capital, Hampstead and its Heath have efficient transport links into the City, as well as motorway routes to the rest of the country.





## Specifications

A place in which every detail has been designed to ensure comfort, peace of mind and quality of living.

## 1.0 External features

Clay facing brickwork to external freestanding walls. Recon cast stonewalling and dressing. Clay roof tiling in Ashurst, sanded finish. European redwood decking to balcony. Glass balustrade to terraces. European oak wood windows. Stained dark timber framed fronted gate, uprights powder coated black nickel finished, remote operator. Front wall – Flemish bond brick work.

#### 2.0 Doors

Internal doors – single panel walnut veneer in a burnished finish throughout.

### 3.0 Study

Polished American walnut flooring. Walnut veneer panelling. Silk moire effect wallpaper, satin curtains, bespoke black lacquer desk with chrome detailing. Nickel deco pendant light.

### 4.0 Dining room

Polished American walnut flooring set in marble border. Bespoke marble fireplace. Lacquered dining table and chairs. Murano glass chandelier.

### 5.0 Drawing room

Polished American walnut flooring set in marble border. Bespoke marble fireplace. Antique nickel side tables and lamps. Water gilded chairs upholstered in satin. Bespoke upholstered furniture. Murano glass chandelier.

## 6.0 Master bedroom

Bamboo carpet. Silk wallpaper. Feature bed head with upholstered wall and mirror detail. Bespoke bedside tables with matching TV unit for 50" TV with Shargreen leather inserts.

7.0 Master en suite bathrooms His bathroom – feature Noir Saint Laurent marble slabs set into Nero Assoluto granite borders. Bespoke solid stone basin Noir Saint Laurent marble. All bathroom fittings from prestigious THG (range Cubica). Rain shower with feature stone benches. Bespoke vanity

unit with faux croc-leather inserts.

Her bathroom – Palissandro Bluette marble slabs. Bespoke solid stone basin fittings from the prestigious company THG (range Cubica). Rain shower. Bespoke vanity unit with Shargreen leather inserts.

## 8.0 Dressing rooms

His dressing room – walnut veneer doors in a burnished finish with chrome details and feature faux croc-leather push plates.

Her dressing room – timber veneer burnished wardrobes with chrome details and open display for bags and shoes.

#### 9.0 Kitchen

Statuario polished marble floor. Faux croc upholstery. Parapan white bespoke walnut units with high gloss white acrylic veneer. White silestone worktops, stainless steel Franke Kubus undermount sinks. Oven, coffee machine, fridgefreezer, dishwasher, washing machine and tumble dryer by Miele. Gaggenau 400 series gas hob. 60" plasma TV.





### 10.0 Cinema

Two tier cinema with velvet upholstered walling. Navy blue 100% wool carpet. 120" full high definition screen, 7.1 digital surround sound and Blu Ray DVD player.

### 11.0 Spa / pool area

5m (Ŵ) x 12m (L) x 1.2m (D) pool. High performance 3 Phase Victoria pump and 600mm top mount Aster filter. Interior – Diamond silver mosaic tiles. Exterior – SUMAC Riven finish tiles with stone border.

#### 12.0 Gym

Woven vinyl flooring. Gym includes the following equipment: TreadMill Ultim8 M4000D, Cross Trainer Ultim8 EP5000, Bike Ultim8 RB3000, Vibration Plate PRO+.

13.0 Heating and cooling All rooms heated via an underfloor heating system, powered by gas fired boilers. Each room can be programmed to a specific temperature via a central touch screen.

Comfort cooling is provided in the main living areas, all bedrooms, as well as gym and cinema / entertainment room. Cooling units are masked by bespoke cabinetry or mounted in lowered ceiling voids.

### 14.0 Lighting

Range of lighting designs throughout the house, the main choice being low voltage down lights. Central lighting system controls the lighting choices for the main rooms. Emergency lighting provided for the main exit routes and plant rooms.

#### 15.0 Audio / visual

Distributed audio system throughout the house with eight active zones. Ceiling speakers in all living rooms, bedrooms and bathrooms. Flat screen displays, including plasma and LCD technology installed throughout the building, as well as connection in place for Sky boxes and disk players.

#### 16.0 Security / access control

System of electrically operated intruder alarms throughout the house, with door contacts, vibration detectors to windows as well as infrared sensors and internal and external sounders. Security lights fitted to the exterior of the building, and a system of up to 16 CCTV cameras monitor the perimeter of the building and the pool area. Video entry system at both the gated entrances, viewed via miniature LCD TV screens inside the house.

## 17.0 Plant room

Hamworthy Chesil heating pressurisation unit with 200 litre expansion vessel and two Hamworthy Purewell variheat condensing boilers. Two Riomay, twin coiled 800 litre calorifiers, each with 100 litre expansion vessel. Brimar cold water sectional storage tank, high nominal capacity 2250 litres. All heating circulation pumps by Armstrong Pumps Ltd. Armstrong 3 pump model water booster set. Hydrotec (UK) Ltd Water Softener. Nuaire Heat Recovery basement ventilation unit and Nuaire twin fan boiler room supply fan.








Site plan









