CULTURALLY RICH

As you would expect, the area surrounding The Lexington is buzzing with life. Camden Arts Centre, Everyman Hampstead and Hampstead Theatre attract top artists and productions, and the Highgate and Hampstead Literary Festival takes place every year in Golders Green.

Hampstead Heath, London's largest parkland, is right on the doorstep with its open air swimming ponds, tennis courts and regular summer lakeside concerts on the slopes by Kenwood House.





SHOPPING IN STYLE

The Lexington is ideally placed for a spot of retail therapy. Fashionable Hampstead Village with its charming array of independent boutiques, restaurants and cafés is only a five minute drive away. Both Golders Green and Temple Fortune high streets are convenient for local shopping whilst Brent Cross Shopping Centre (less than ten minutes by car) and Westfield Shopping Centre (20 minutes by car) are excellent for their extensive retail offer. Bond Street is just 24 minutes by tube.*





The Lexington is conveniently situated on the Finchley Road in North West London, adjacent to the centres of Golders Green and Hampstead. Residents of The Lexington will find themselves perfectly placed to take advantage of the local area's retail and leisure facilities.



INDIVIDUALLY CRAFTED

The Lexington offers a superb range of homes; one, two and three bedroom apartments, duplexes, penthouse apartments and mews houses. Each home has been individually designed and painstakingly crafted to offer space and light. Each has its own outdoor space, be it patio garden, terrace or balcony, or a combination.

THE MANSION & THE COURTYARD

Apartments and a handful of duplexes are in these two adjoining buildings, offering a choice of layouts. There's something for everyone at The Lexington.

Alongside a select number of one bedroom apartments, the unusually spacious two and three bedroom apartments benefit from the high specification found in each and every one of the homes.

Each apartment has a patio garden, balcony or terrace for those balmy summer evenings.





THE PENTHOUSE COLLECTION

The seven penthouses are The Lexington's crowning glory. They enjoy great views from their enviable position on the top floor, maximised by the over-sized windows and doors which open out onto large or wrap-around terraces – perfect for al fresco entertaining.

Offering a choice of two or three bedrooms, the penthouses offer individual layouts, stunning attention to detail and an enhanced specification.

THE MEWS

Tucked away with their own private entrances are The Mews. Comprising just three, two and three bedroom houses, these homes - with their large walnut veneer front doors - are undeniably smart yet retain a warm, homely feel.

In addition to the high quality specification offered in all homes at The Lexington, there is a host of additional features in the houses. They also benefit from a patio front garden and first floor balcony as well as access to communal landscaped gardens.













APARTMENT AND HOUSE DETAIL

Attention to detail is evident throughout. Homes are characterised by high ceilings and over-sized windows, fabulous flooring and underfloor heating, generous storage space, utility rooms*, fitted wardrobes or dressing areas*, stylish bespoke German kitchens with Miele appliances, and high specification Villeroy and Boch bathrooms and en-suites* with Hansgrohe taps and showers.

And there's even an Aquavision TV for those moments relaxing in the bath!






A FULL RANGE OF FACILITIES

The Lexington meets The Code for Sustainable Homes Level 3 - efficient building materials with enhanced insulation, double glazed windows, green roofs, green climbing walls, photovoltaic panels* and a central 'Combined Heat and Power' system for underfloor heating & hot water: all designed to help reduce energy bills whilst being kind on the environment.

In addition, secure underground parking (some with electric charging points) and storage rooms are available under separate negotiation. Basement bike storage is also available.

PEACE OF MIND

Busy residents will appreciate the concierge service located in the large entrance foyer to assist with safe receipt of mail and deliveries as well as providing a sense of security that comes with such a service. The homes have been designed to give owners peace of mind; communal door entry is by fob, there are video entry phones in each apartment, and all homes are pre-wired for intruder alarms.








RELAX AND UNWIND








PRESTIGIOUS AND ON-TREND

A CENTRE OF LEARNING EXCELLENCE






WORLD CLASS CONNECTIONS

The transport links within London are world class. The capital has an extensive transport network comprising the Underground, London Overground, the Docklands Light Railway, London Buses, Tramlink, and the River Bus Services as well as its iconic black taxi cabs.

The London Underground has 11 lines, the majority of which connect the suburbs to Central London, making it easy to reach anywhere in the capital. The Docklands Light Railway, which has five main branches, serves the Docklands area of east London, focusing on the Canary Wharf business district.

London's airports include Gatwick, Heathrow, London City, Luton and Stansted.

Away from the hustle and bustle yet still well connected, The Lexington provides excellent access to all parts of London.

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The London Underground is very accessible with the Northern line just over 10 minutes' walk away at Golders Green, providing direct trains into Central London and the City. The Jubilee line is available at West Hampstead and Finchley Road, just a short bus journey away. These stations also offer Overground links.

Buses to Central London (Chelsea/Kensington/Hyde Park/Oxford Circus) stop directly outside The Lexington while the M1 is a mere 6 minutes' drive away, and the M25 only 21 minutes away.

London's major international airports are within an hour's journey, with regular underground services to London City Airport and Heathrow. Kings Cross St Pancras International - where the Eurostar provides a regular service to Brussels and Paris - is just 18 minutes drive away.*
