BILLIONS 'WASTED' ON HOTELS FOR MIGRANTS

Bombshell report reveals 'incompetent'
Home Office staff let private firms make
'excessive profits' from small boat crisis

THE Home Office
'squandered' billions of
pounds on asylum
hotels, a damning report
reveals today.

MPs blasted its 'incompe-
tence' at handling a 'failed,
chaotic, expensive' system.

There was a 'manifest failure' by
the department to get a grip on
contracts with the private compa-
nies it appointed to house asylum
seekers, they concluded.

As a result, these firms had been
allowed to make 'excessive profits'

from the Channel migrant crisis. In
one of the most critical reports ever
published about the dysfunctional
department, the MPs said it was
'not up to this challenge' and
demanded major changes.

It comes as Labour continues to
struggle to get on top of the crisis,
with more than 60,000 arrivals since
